This high-reading course focuses primarily on Paris, London and Vienna, while covering however a much larger number of European cities (Florence, Rome, Berlin, Madrid, Lisbon, Prague, Moscow, etc.); also, while it concentrates on modernity, it does involve historical excursions, and while streets, buildings, and neighborhoods are much talked about, countless other aspects are covered (shops and shop-life; boulevard culture; private life; street practices; etc.).
