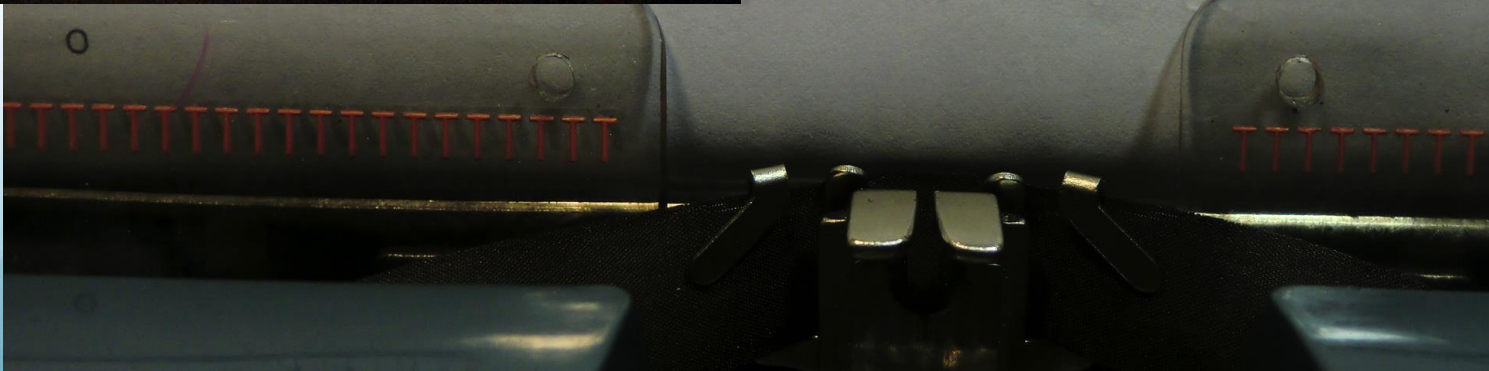

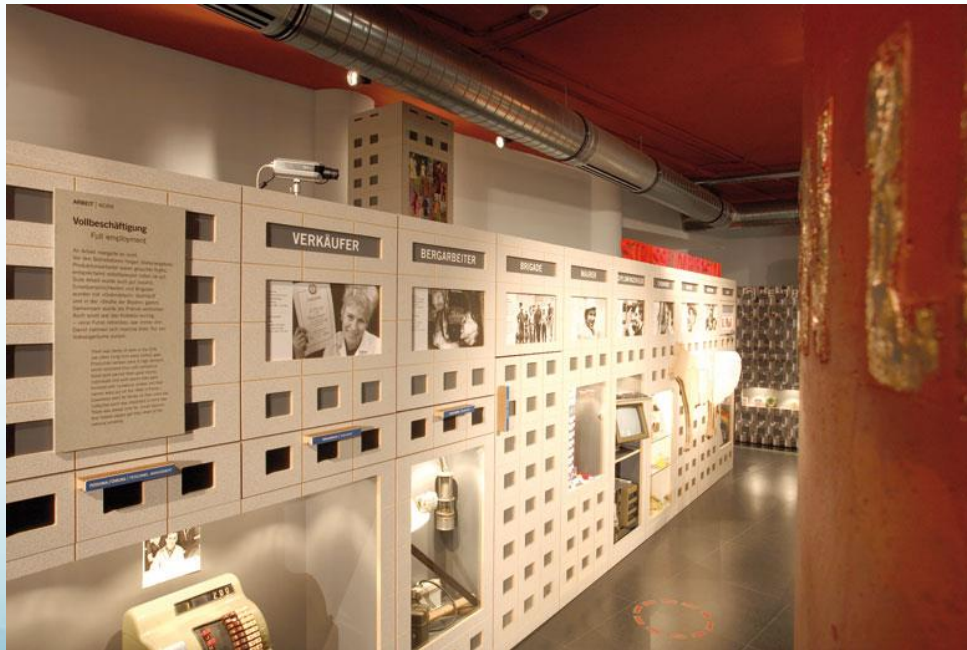

- The restoration and installation of the picture cost 20,000Euros.



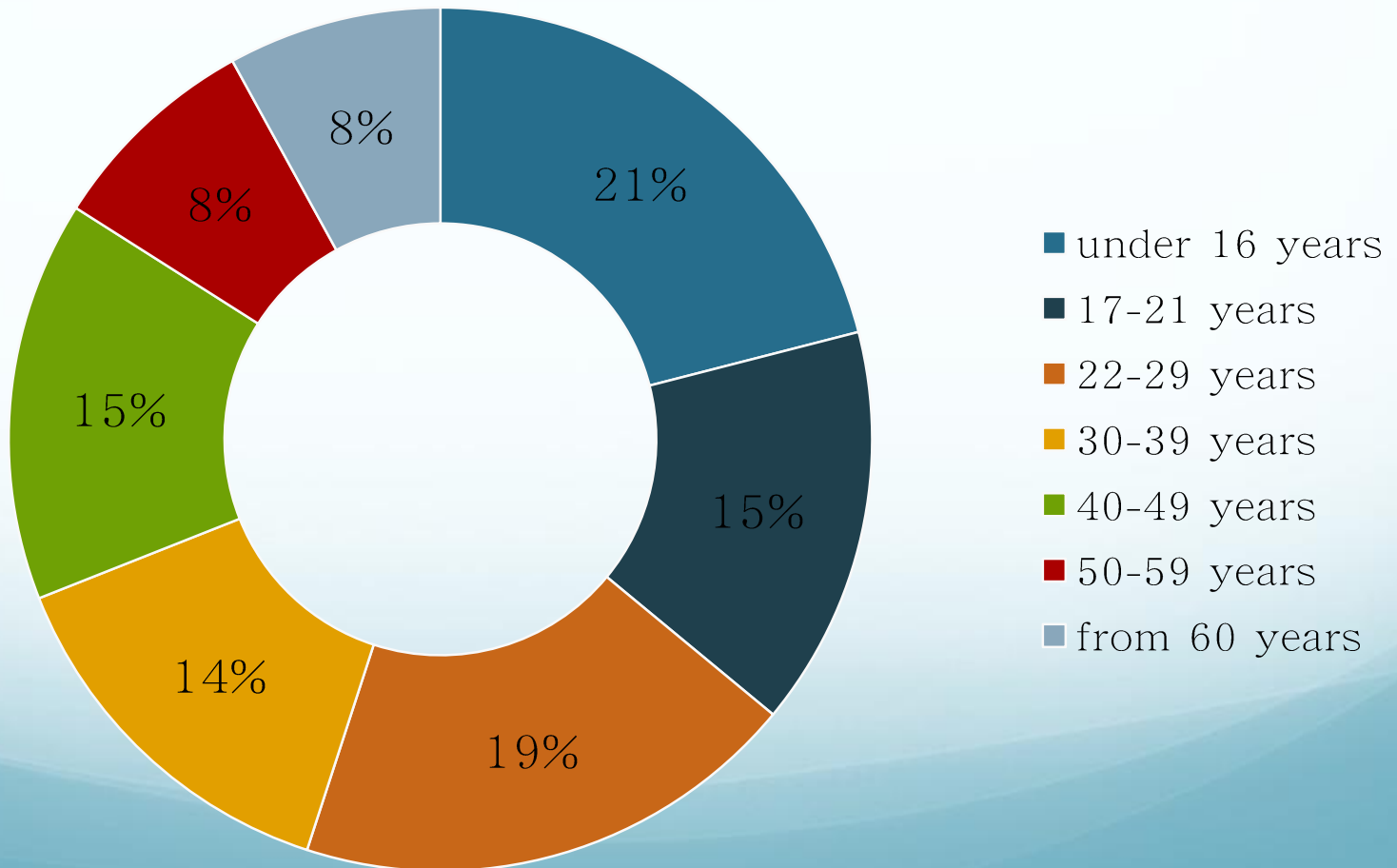

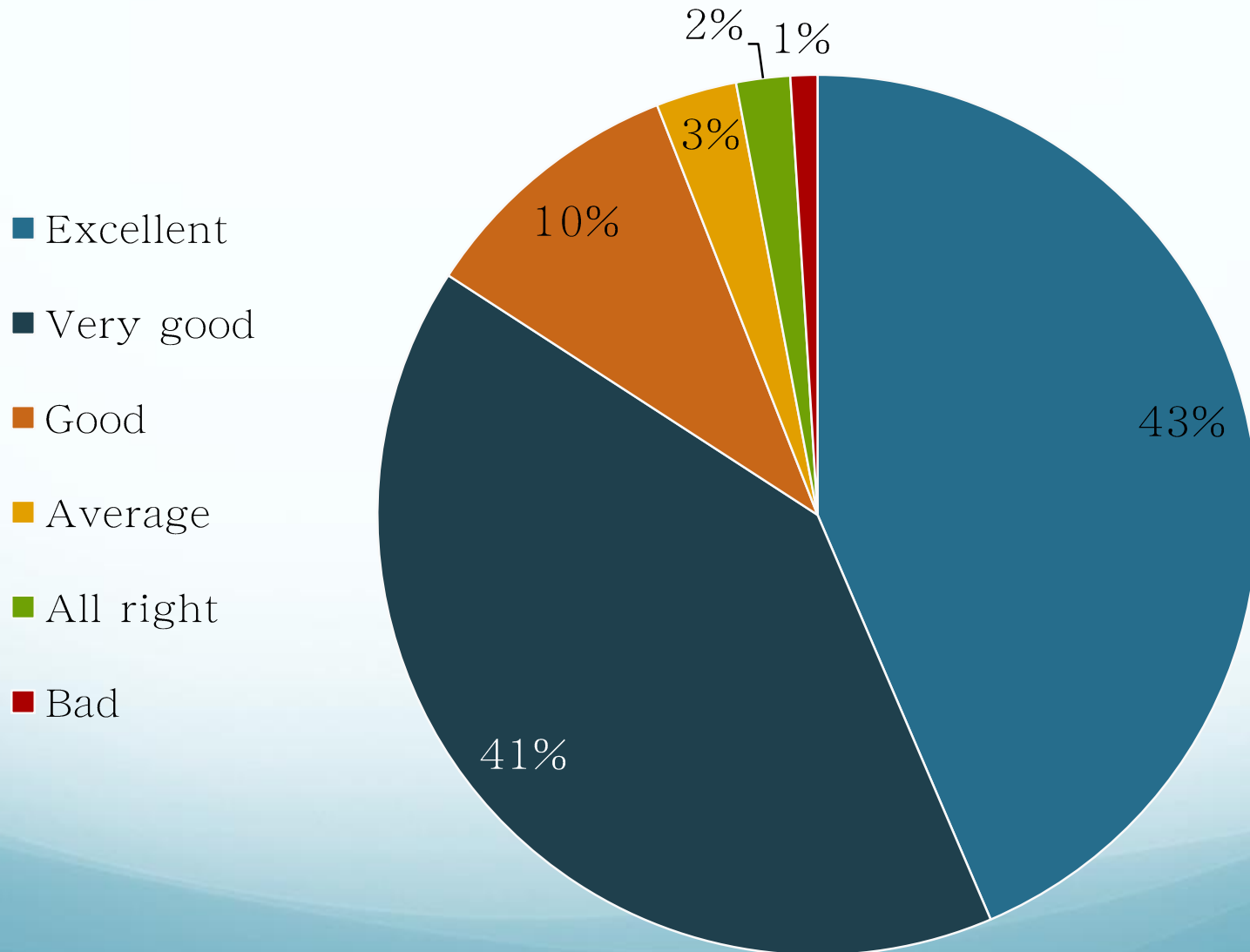
