- Article 1 These Rules were established to help students develop exceptional competitiveness by engaging in research or practical work in the fields of European cultures and cultural tourism.
- Article 2 The students of the Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism (hereinafter referred to as "the Graduate Institute") must meet the criteria set forth in each of the two following paragraphs in order to graduate:
 - I. One or more of the following three criteria for academic papers or certification:
 - (I) Journal publication of one academic paper presented at a symposium in Taiwan or overseas.
 - (II) Language proficiency certification in a European language equivalent to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) B1 or higher. For details, see Article 3 below.
 - (III) Qualification as a European language (French, German, or Spanish) tour guide or tour manager in Taiwan.
 - II. One or more of the following three criteria for experience in Europe:
 - (I) Participation in the Graduate Institute's elective course titled "European Cultures and Tourism—Off-site Learning."
 - (II) Enrollment in a joint degree program or exchange program established with a European university.
 - (III) Participation in an off-site research or internship program of one month or longer in Europe. The research or internship program must be reviewed and approved by the Institute General Meeting prior to participation.

Article 3 European language proficiency certification:

- I. The students of the Graduate Institute must meet at least one of the criteria for European language proficiency certification set forth below before they graduate:
 - (I) Official language proficiency certification in a European language (English not included) equivalent to CEFR B1 or above.
 - (II) Level B1 or above in passive language skills (listening and reading comprehension) in the proficiency certification of a European language; applications must be submitted together with the passing criteria for certification in the given year.
 - (III) Successful completion of the Graduate Institute's language proficiency examination for a European language (For more information, please refer to the Graduate Institute's Regulations on European Language Certification.)
 - (IV) Completion of 216 course hours in a European language (English not included) and submission of an academic transcript demonstrating course completion with a passing grade.

- Article 4 These Rules are applicable to new students of the Graduate Institute starting in Academic Year 2019-2020.
- Article 5 These Rules shall be promulgated and take effect after being passed at the General Meeting of the Graduate Institute. The same applies to all subsequent amendments.
