

Regulations Governing the Implementation of European Language Tests at the National Taiwan Normal University Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism

1. The Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism (hereafter “this Institute”) hereby establishes the Regulations Governing the Implementation of European Language Tests at the National Taiwan Normal University Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism to verify whether students meet the graduation requirements.

2. Application procedure:

Submit an application to the office of this Institute at the end of April and November each year.

3. Examination date:

Examination will be held two weeks before the end of the semester as announced by the Office of Academic Affairs. The exact examination date will be announced on a later date.

4. Examination content:

Academic article translation (from foreign languages to Chinese) totaling two paragraphs and 600-700 words. The topic of the article will be related to the research directions of this Institute.

5. Notification of exam results:

Students will be notified of their examination results one week after the examination. The passing score is 70.

6. Standard fee:

Each student will be charged NT\$1,000 for the examination. The fee will be used to pay for preparing, marking, and proctoring the examination.

7. The Regulations will come into effect after they are approved during the graduate institute affairs meeting. The same principle will apply when amendments are made.
