

Regulations Governing the Establishment of Scholarship at the National Taiwan Normal University Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism

1. The Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism (hereafter “this Institute”) hereby establishes two categories of scholarship to encourage students to actively engage in European culture and tourism-related research.
 - (1) Scholarship for academic excellence: Students may receive only one award throughout their years of study.
 - (2) Scholarship for research excellence: Scholarship awarded to outstanding academic papers in Italian subjects.
2. Amount of scholarship
NT\$50,000 per student per academic year.
3. Number of students awarded and eligibility
 - (1) Scholarship for academic excellence:
 1. Number of students awarded: one for both second-year and third-year master’s students.
 2. Eligibility: Only graduate students of this Institute are eligible for the scholarships. Second-year and third-year master’s students applying for the scholarships must have taken at least five courses (15 credits) and three courses (9 credits), respectively, in the previous academic year. Also, students must have passed all the courses and have the potential to conduct academic research.
 - (2) Scholarship for research excellence:
 1. Number of students awarded: The number of students awarded varies between different fields as specified by the providers.
 2. Eligibility: Second-year master’s students studying at this Institute may not apply for more than one scholarship. Students’ papers must have been published in domestic or foreign academic journals (with a review mechanism) over the past year.
4. Application time and procedure
 - (1) Scholarship for academic excellence:

Students who meet the scholarship application criteria shall submit the following documents to this Institute before October 31 of each year.

1. The application form
2. A photocopy of the student ID and National Identification Card
3. An original copy of the student's transcript from the previous academic year

(2) Scholarship for research excellence:

Students who meet the scholarship application criteria shall submit the following documents to this Institute after their papers have been published in the academic journals.

1. The application form
2. A photocopy of the student ID and National Identification Card
3. An original copy of the academic journal with the student's paper.

5. Review committee

The scholarship review committee consists of three members: the director of this Institute and two faculty member representatives. The director serves as the review committee convener.

6. Application review process

Applications are first submitted to the graduate institute affairs meeting, which will perform a preliminary review where academic performance and activity participation account for 75% and 25%, respectively. Applications will then be submitted to the scholarship review committee for approval. Once approved, the scholarships will be announced publicly and issued.

7. The Regulations Governing the Establishment of Scholarship at the National Taiwan Normal University Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism are implemented once they have been approved by the review committee. The same principle applies when amendments are made.
