Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism Regulations Governing Alternative European Experience Graduation Requirements Evaluation

2020.12.11 Passed during the 3rd Institute Affairs Meeting of the Graduate Institute of European Cultures and

Tourism, Academic Year 2020-2021

Article 1 Eligibility:

1. Open to students who were unable to enroll in the European Cultures and Tourism Off-site Learning course that is usually offered to first-year Master's degree students during the summer vacation but was closed for enrollment due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Article 2 Implementation:

- 1. Students shall attend five Europe-related events organized in Taiwan and obtain proof of attendance.
- 2. Students shall submit one or more 5000-word reports detailing their thoughts on the five events they attended, preferably with a central unifying theme.
- 3. Reviews will be handled in the order they are received. Students will be notified of their review results within one month (20 school days) after submission of their reports. Students who pass the review will be deemed to have met the graduation criteria for European experience.
- 4. At least three out of the five events attended must be Europe-related events recognized by the Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism as listed in Table 1.
