Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism Regulations Governing for the Selection of Joint Dual-Degree Program Students Evaluation (Effective Academic Year 2017)

- Article 1. The Graduate Institute of European Cultures and Tourism ("the Institute")hereby establishes these *Regulations for the Selection of Joint Dual-Degree Program Students* ("the Regulations") to select joint dual-degree program students to undertake advanced studies in foreign schools.
- Article 2. Joint dual-degree program students must submit application documents to the Institute on the first day of school in February of each year. The applications will be reviewed by the Institute Affairs Meeting, and the list of students selected for the program will be announced in mid-March.

Article 3. Eligibility requirements:

1. Students who have completed two academic years of study, completed the thesis proposal defense, achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.76 or above, and received a TOEFL iBT score of 92 or above (or equivalent, as detailed in Article 4.3) will be eligible to study in the joint dual-degree program.

Article 4. Required documents:

- 1. Application form
- 2. Original copy of the complete academic transcript
- 3. A copy of the English proficiency test certificate (TOEFL iBT score of 92, TOEIC score of 730, IELTS score of 6.5, or other equivalent scores)
- 4. A study plan
- 5. A letter of recommendation from the thesis advisor
- 6. A copy of the French proficiency test certificate (not required butrecommended)

Article 5. Selection method:

1. Selections will be made by reviewing the applicants' documents, with interviews conducted when necessary.

- Article 6. Admitted students are required to complete their Master's thesis defense before going abroad to study in the joint dual-degree program. Those who fail to complete their defense on time will be disqualified.
- Article 7. Admitted students must remit a security deposit of NT\$10,000, which will be refunded after the student fulfills the obligations stipulated in Article 8. If a student withdraws from their overseas studies after admission with the required documents submitted to the designated NTNU partner school, the security deposit will not be refunded and the student will be denied permission to study in a joint dual-degree program unless the student can show that the withdrawal was due to force majeure (valid proof must be attached).
- Article 8. Joint dual-degree program students shall fulfill the following obligations:
 - 1. Those who complete the registration procedures at the exchange school will be treated as a student of that school and shall comply with the laws and regulations of NTNU, the partner school, and the country in which the partner school is located. Students shall not act in a manner that damages the reputation of either school or violates the laws of either country.
 - 2. Students may not shorten or extend the length of their studies without the consent of both the Institute and the partner school.
- Article 9. After a joint dual-degree program student meets the graduation requirements stipulated by the Institute and the partner school, they will receive a diploma from NTNU as well as a joint dual-degree graduation certificate issued by the partner school.
- Article 10. These Regulations shall come into effect after being passed by the Institute Affairs Meeting. The same principle shall apply when revisions are made.
